Requirements

There are a few requirements that have to be taken in account:

- Assign one person as the main contact person between the club and Roundnet Belgium
- Your club has to organise at least one tournament each year. If you need help setting up a tournament, you can always contact us.
- Create a web page where interested parties can contact you. You do not have to create your own web page (although we recommend this), a Facebook page is sufficient.
- Develop a logo for name recognition. Be creative and create a logo that suits your club!



Recommendations

Certain aspects are not required but are highly recommended.

- **Active engagement:**
An important goal of Roundnet Belgium is to let everybody in Belgium get acquainted with the sport. Therefore, we stimulate that a club welcomes everybody in the community. It is recommended that a club organises a two weekly session (at least 25 times a year).
- Stimulate your members to sign up with Roundnet Belgium. It is completely free and comes with additional benefits.
- Try to contact your commune and see what they have to offer for sport clubs. Often, every city/village has their own policies regarding the support of sports.
- Make sure your members are insured. You can take out your own insurance but there are easier ways for small sport clubs. For example, the club can become member of a multi-sport federation (e.g. Sporta). Apart from the insurance, they offer other services as well.
- Try to grow to a structured organisation. We applaud clubs who create their own policies. For example, you can apply for a non-profit organisation.
